NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-12.
- 1.2** The following prescriptions of South African Sailing will apply:
"The SA Sailing Requirements for National Championships".
- 1.3** Boats participating in this regatta shall conform to the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) 2009-12, the Class Rules of each Class, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. The requirements for Measurement Certificates does not apply to the RS Terra Class

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C. ISAF Regulation 20 applies.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** In accordance with the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) Regulation 19 (Eligibility Code), all competitors (Helmspersons and all other crew) shall be members in good standing of a Yacht Club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing or their Member National Authority in the case of non-South Africans. The Yacht Club name and membership details shall be stated on the entry form or crew list. Current valid South African Sailing Membership Cards or similar proof of MNA Membership in cases of non-South Africans shall be presented at Registration.
- 3.2** The regatta is open to all boats of the above listed class.

- 3.3** In cases of electronic or faxed entry, confirmation of payment as outlined in 3.3 above shall clearly bear the following reference number **SAS KZN Provincials – Name** and be faxed or e-mailed, together with the Entry, to the Regatta Secretary.
- 3.4** Late entries will be accepted.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

4.2 Other Fees:

All Entry Fees and Class subscriptions shall be paid prior to the close of Registration. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the affected yacht being recorded as Did Not Compete until such time as the required payment/s are made. This changes rule A11 (DNC)

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration:

Day and date Monday 27th December From 09h00 to 11h00

5.2 Measurement and inspection:

Day and date Monday 27th December From 09h00 to 11h00

5.3 A Non Compulsory Briefing will be held on Monday 27th December at 11h30 in the HMYC clubhouse

5.4 Dates of racing:

The first race is scheduled to start at 13h00 on 27th December 2010.

5.5 Number of races for the regatta is 15

5.6 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of each day is 08h55

5.7 No race will be started after 14h30 on the last scheduled day of racing, except in the unlikely event of a fourth qualifying race being required, this race will be started no later than 16h.30

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement / rating certificate. In addition spot measurements may be taken at any stage during the regatta.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Regatta Secretary on completion of registration formalities.

8 VENUE

Racing will take place on Midmar Dam

9 THE COURSES

The diagrams in Addendum A & B. show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 will apply

11 SCORING

11.1 Low Point System of Appendix A4.1 will apply.

11.2 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 11.3**
- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - (c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races excluding her two worst scores.

12 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify as a National Class Championship the following criteria shall be satisfied:

- * A minimum of ten valid entries have been received no later than the closing time for entries one hour before the scheduled starting time of the first race
- * At least ten finishers in any two races of the series.
- * At least four races completed.

13 PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify as a Provincial Class Championship the following criteria shall be satisfied:

- * A minimum of ten valid entries have been received no later than the closing time for entries one hour before the scheduled starting time of the first race
- * At least ten finishers in any one race of the series.
- * At least four races completed.

14 SAFETY

14.1 Yachts shall comply with the National Small Vessel Safety Regulations, as well as their class buoyancy and safety requirements.

- 14.2** Yachts shall comply with their class buoyancy and safety requirements
- 14.3** Youth category competitors shall wear a personal buoyancy aid at all times while afloat in a yacht.
- 14.4** Wet or dry suits do not constitute adequate buoyancy!

15 SUPPORT BOATS

Coach or individual support boats shall be marked and remain no less than 150m from areas where boats are racing, between the Preparatory Signal and the last competitor finishing the race. Failure to comply shall result in action from the Protest Committee.

16 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:
Sprog National Championship Trophy
Sprog Family Trophy

SA Medals will awarded in accordance with the following:

10 to 14 yachts finished at least two races – GOLD
15 to 19 yachts finished at least two races – GOLD and SILVER
20 or more yachts finished at least two races – GOLD, SILVER and BRONZE

KZN Medals will be awarded in accordance with the following:

10 to finish 1 race - GOLD
11 to finish 1 race - GOLD SILVER and BRONZE

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the Organizing Authority nor its officials or other persons associated with the organization of the event will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat is encouraged to carry sufficient valid third-party liability insurance to cover any liability arising during the event.
